ZERO INFECTION IPP PROTOCOL

- All preoperative antibiotics have to be completed before surgical incision (Give before taking the pt to OR suite in order to allow proper tissue level)
- **Inside the OR:** Replace BLANKETS and SHEETS with sterile half sheet prior to entering the OR suite to minimize contamination.
- Ask patient to void in pre-op (straight catheterize patient if did not void- irrigate distal urethra with betadine prior to prep)
- **Skin Prep** Hibiclens and them Cloraprep perform a thorough skin prep making 100% sure the foreskin is pulled back and scrubbed diligently. **If this is difficult to do, please notify surgeon prior to proceeding.**
- Dry off Hibiclens before applying the Chloraprep!
- All OR scrubbed personnel are to DOUBLE GLOVE with frequent glove changes.
- Limit OR traffic once room is open
- Implant boxes are NOT to be open (Assembly & Reservoir) until patient is fully draped.
